Subject: Criteria for Sponsorship of Tournament Teams for the ____ Season

This is an open letter to teams that seek sponsorship from the Redwood City Señors Softball Club. It describes the process and criteria for applying for Club sponsorship for the upcoming playing season and invites teams to submit applications.

Background: It has long been a custom for the Redwood City Señors Softball Club to support our Club members who are involved in tournament play within the Northern California Senior Softball Association (NCSSA) and Senior Softball USA (SSUSA). If a group of Club members were to form a tournament team, they can seek Club sponsorship for that team. There will be a limited number of teams sponsored. Each team that applies for sponsorship will be evaluated on certain criteria to be eligible.

Criteria for Selection of Teams to Be Sponsored by the Club:

1. The percentage of players who are Club members at the time of application;
2. The percentage of players who were Club members during the year prior to application for sponsorship;
3. The median distance of the home address of all players and Red Morton Park, Redwood City;
4. The degree of participation by players in other Club activities and functions;
5. Demonstrated past volunteer services by team players in support of various Club functions.

Application and Selection Process:

The Manager/Coach of any team seeking sponsorship should prepare a written statement or verbal presentation that addresses the above criteria for selection, complete the attached application and then deliver and/or present their request for sponsorship to the Board of Directors at a regularly scheduled Board meeting (normally in the first week of each month) at the Veterans Memorial Senior Center Library, at 7:00 pm. Contact must be made with a Board Member prior to the meeting date, so that the application request can be placed on the agenda for the next meeting. The Board will entertain applications at any time during the year; however, in order to take full advantage of the benefits involved, applicants are advised to apply prior to January 1 of the year they intend to play. Each application received will be reviewed and discussed by the Board of Directors and their final decision will be later communicated to the requesting team.
